



Editing a freely-definable table in Excel format

- Procedure:
1. Transmit the freely-definable table to the PC
 2. Open Excel
 3. Data tab \Rightarrow Get External Data \Rightarrow From Text
 4. Select file
 5. Enter the relevant information in the Wizard

The Text Wizard has determined that your data is delimited.

Original data type

Choose the file type that best describes your data:

- Delimited - Characters such as commas or tabs separate each field.
- Fixed width - Fields are aligned in columns with spaces between each field.
